<p>(C) Took Primary Prevention Brochure to Parent Advisory Committee (FFPSA group). CWS loves the brochure; Kern is spread out with geographic regions---could add info geographically. Want to put in kids’ backpacks. The Advisory Group thought it was too long. Also discussed at county convening on prevention services---had discussions about how it might work (benefits application, etc., DR providers could work directly with families). Stakeholders said that it is overwhelming---need to give one resource---e.g. an FRC. Trying to figure out how to get a modified version with all Protective Factors on 1 page, with list of FRC’s on the other side.</p>	<p>Kern</p>
<p>(I)LA had same concerns as Kern. 2 different things— helping families in crisis navigate to specific resources; also helpful to have more resources available to larger population</p>	<p>LA</p>

<p>(W) Dedicated Prevention Section; programs are using 5 Protective Factors and evaluating (pre and post test) –very intentional in keeping children out of CWS and addressing disproportionality; working on FFPSA; taking prevention focus as paradigm shift</p>	<p>Santa Clara</p>
<p>(W) Doing similar work---coordinated Prevention and Early Intervention with all agencies in the county (not just CWS); finding parallels but wants to align with goals of other agencies. How about other counties? Extending beyond CalWORKs families—Together for Children in Santa Barbara County</p>	<p>Santa Barbara</p>
<p>(C)Thinking about how to do an early intervention process; workload issue, business process issue</p>	<p>Calaveras</p>
<p>(C) Discussed Early Intervention with Exec Team—too much going on during first interactions with family. Families are getting so much information this can get lost in the shuffle.</p>	<p>Kern</p>
<p>I) Going live with CalSAWS; has a robust portal; good place to post brochure and other information; could use for a self-screening tool as well</p>	<p>Santa Barbara</p>

(I For people not on cash aid but in general population; put information at Walmart—QR code to bring up Protective Factors brochure. Make available to general public—maybe they don't need it but might know someone who might need it. Access easily throughout the community.	
(I Integrated with CPP and SIP. County-wide motivational interviewing training with all partners throughout the county. May not be able to track FFPSA fidelity but using FFPS funds to build capacity county-wide; open to all providers. 3 three-hour sessions over the course of a month; filling up the seats	Kern
