CalWORKs services include:

- Monetary assistance
- Cal-Fresh (food stamps) and
- Medi-Cal services.

Welfare-to-Work services include:

- Temporary homeless assistance
- Mental Health Services
- Substance Abuse Counseling & Treatment
- Domestic Abuse Counseling
- Housing Support Services
- Family Stabilization Services (FSS)
- Welfare-to-Work activities and supportive services

If a family has little
or no cash and needs housing,
food, utilities, clothing or
medical care, they may be
eligible to receive
immediate help.
