# WHAT IS THE LINKAGES PROGRAM?

A partnership between Children's Services and Self-Sufficiency Divisions that helps families access needed services so they can be financially stable and safely parent their children.

## Available Services



CalWORKs services include:

- Monetary assistance
- Cal-Fresh (food stamps) and
- Medi-Cal services.

Welfare-to-Work services include:

- Temporary homeless assistance
- Mental Health Services
- Substance Abuse Counseling & Treatment
- Domestic Abuse Counseling
- Housing Support Services
- Family Stabilization Services (FSS)
- Welfare-to-Work activities and supportive services and more...
